Through the **ENERGY STAR Leaders** program, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency recognizes organizations for energy efficiency achievements across their entire portfolio of commercial buildings. Annual recognition is offered in two categories: 1) **Portfolio-wide improvement**, awarded in increments of 10 percent; 2) **Top Performance**, awarded to organizations whose entire portfolio averages in the top 25% of energy performance nationwide.
